Parking of any non-parade vehicle will not be allowed on any roadway or access

All parade vehicles must complete the full parade route. Follow East Main Street to the end where East Main Street meets 19 E. This will be at the Subway light. Do not cut through any of the area including the Shell station. Keep in follow with parade route. On 19E stay in right lane, back to starting area. Parade walkers can arrange for pickup at the end of East Main Street. Dixie Styles Antiques parking lot will be reserved area for horses.

If you begin parade on a float or in a vehicle, you must remain on the float until end of parade – Sorry, no exceptions. Anyone walking with floats or vehicles must walk with their floats or vehicle, keeping up with flow of parade – Sorry, no exceptions.

You may distributed candy. Candy must be thrown from the side of vehicles toward the sidewalk area and not at individuals. No throwing toward front of vehicle is permitted.

Each parade vehicle/float is required to assign a responsible party at time of entry. This party must remain with the parade vehicle/float at all times and will be designated as the only contact person. NO DRIVERS UNDER THE AGE OF 18.

RULES FOR DRIVER

Please watch for Children – Yield to Pedestrians.

Minimize the gap between you and the entry in front of you. Don't crowd them but stay close. Please help us keep the parade moving.
